We hope that these changes will meet your requirements.



This is to acknowledge your letter of April 8th altering your application for permission to commingle production from your New Mexico "C" Lease, which is located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 7, Township 11 South, Range 34 East, Lea County, and your State of New Mexico "I" Lease, which is located in the Northeast Quarter of Section 7, Township 11 South, Range 34 East, Lea County. It is our understanding that you are altering your proposal to provide separate metering facilities for each of the power oil sources and each of the lease production sources.

Dear Sir:

We are at the present time commingling oil produced from our State of New Mexico "C" Lease comprising the NW/4 of Section 7 and our State of New Mexico "I" Lease comprising the NE/4 of Section 7, Township 11 South, Range 34 East, Inbe-Pennsylvania Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. Administrative order CTB-154 approving the above commingled facility was granted April 15, 1966, by the Oil Conservation Commission.

This letter is our application for exception to Rule 309A and permission to expand our existing hydraulic pumping system to include the St. of New Mexico "A" Well No. 2, 660' FW and WL, SE/4 of Section 7, Township 11 South, Range 34 East, Inbe-Pennsylvania Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

These leases are 100% Sun Oil Company owned and have the same beneficiary, Common Schools of New Mexico. Completion of the St. "A" Well No. 2 is scheduled for the same reservoir as the St. "C" and "I" Leases, the Bough "C" in the Inbe-Penn Pool. The only other well on the St. "A" Lease, Well No. 1, is completed in the Upper Wolfcamp and will remain a separate facility.

Lease plats and diagrams of production and test facilities for the commingled system are attached.






Proposed Lease Commencing





