

Gentlemen:

We have received your request to commingle production from your State "DA" Well No. 1 and your State "DE" Well No. 1 located respectively in the SWNW and SESW of Section 35, Township 7 South, Range 33 East, Roosevelt County, New Mexico. Due to the fact that the production to be commingled is from one lease, the same pool and common beneficiary, please be advised that the Commissioner of Public Lands has no objection to your proposal as outlined by the letter which you sent to the Oil Conservation Commission on April 28, 1966.

In analyzing our correspondence to determine the delay in this matter, we have discovered you have the wrong post office box for the State Land Office. The State Land Office Post Office Box is, 1148 and should be used rather than Post Office Box 2088, which is the post office box for the Oil Conservation Commission. This should facilitate our correspondence in the future.

Roosevelt County, New Mexico.


In support of our request for exception to Rule 309-A, and under the provisions of Rule 309-B to permit the commingling of production from two separate leases into a common tank battery without notice and hearing, the following is submitted:

1. Plats of the leases, showing thereon the wells and the formation in which they are completed.
2. Schematic diagram of the commingling facility, located in Unit E, Section 35, T-7-S, R-33-E, Roosevelt County, New Mexico.
3. Production is from a common source of supply, and the commercial value of the commingled production will be unchanged.
4. All parties owning an interest in the leases and the purchaser of the commingled production have been notified by certified mail of our intention to commingle the production from these leases.

5. The production will be separately measured, utilizing A. O. Smith T-6 temperature compensated meters equipped with samplers. A BS&W reading will be taken each eight days and production recorded.
6. Production from the separate leases is diversified, and each lease shall be accurately measured and determined in accordance with the "Manual For Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."


