Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated July 11, 1966, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of oil produced from your Federal NM 0108997-A Lease comprising the S/2 of Section 26 and your Federal NM 0127782 Lease comprising the NE/4 NE/4 and S/2 NE/4 of Section 27, all in Township 7 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Chaveroo-San Andres Pool, Roosevelt County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each lease. Your application enclosed the consent of the United States Geological Survey to such commingling.

Under the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-B, Kern County Land Company is hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission's "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made prior to putting it in operation.
