Pan American Petroleum Corporation respectfully requests and submits application for administrative approval for the commingling of production from separate leases as follows:

Baskett Lease - Units L and M, Section 11, T-7-S, R-30-E,  
N.M.P.M., Chaves County, New Mexico.

Baskett "B" Lease - Units C and F, Section 11, T-7-S, R-30-E,  
N.M.P.M., Chaves County, New Mexico.


In support of our request for exception to Rule 309-A and under the provisions of Rule 309-B to permit the commingling of production from two separate leases into a common tank battery without notice and hearing the following is submitted:

1. Plats of the leases showing thereon the wells and the formation in which they are completed.
2. Schematic diagram of the commingling facility to be called the Cato Storage System I, located in Unit L, Section 11, T-7-S, R-30-E, N.M.P.M., Chaves County, New Mexico. The meter and sampler shown are not required for this application. They will be installed, however, in anticipation of additional expansion for which approval will be obtained when necessary.

3. Production is from a common source of supply, and the commercial value of the commingled production will be unchanged.
4. All parties owning an interest in the leases and the purchaser of the commingled production have been notified by certified mail of our intention to commingle the production from these leases.
5. Production from the separate leases is common as to working interest ownership, royalty ownership, and overriding royalty ownership. Adequate facilities will be installed to permit determining the producing capacity of each well on each lease at least once each month in accordance with applicable provisions of the current Commission Manual For the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities.




