Dear Sir:

Effective September 13, 1966, CTB-162 provided for the commingling of production from the Baskett and Baskett "B" Leases at our Cato Storage System I. An application, dated September 12, 1966, to commingle the Baskett "C" and Queen Leases with the Cato Storage System I, is pending. We now respectfully request an extension to CTB-162 be granted to permit commingling of the Baskett "D" Lease with the Cato Storage System I.

The combined application for the commingling of production consists of the following leases:

Baskett Lease - W/2 of SW/4, Section 11, T-8-S, R-30-E, N.M.P.M.,
Chaves County, New Mexico.

Baskett "B" Lease - E/2 of NW/4, Section 11, T-8-S, R-30-E,
N.M.P.M., Chaves County, New Mexico.

Baskett "C" Lease - W/2 of SE/4, Section 10, T-8-S, R-30-E,
N.M.P.M., Chaves County, New Mexico.

Baskett "D" Lease - E/2 of Section 11, T-8-S, R-30-E, N.M.P.M.,
Chaves County, New Mexico.

Queen Lease - NW/4, Section 10, T-8-S, R-30-E, N.M.P.M., Chaves
County, New Mexico.

In support of our request for exception to Rule 309-A and under the provisions of Rule 309-B to permit the commingling of production from two or more separate leases into a common tank battery without notice and hearing the following is submitted:

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2. Schematic diagram of the commingling facility, called the Cato Storage System I, located in Unit L, Section 11, T-8-S, R-30-E, N.M.P.M., Chaves County, New Mexico.
3. Production is from a common source of supply, and the commercial value of the commingled production will be unchanged.
4. All parties owning an interest in the leases and the purchaser of the commingled production have been notified by certified mail of our intention to commingle the production from these leases.
5. Production from the Baskett, Baskett "B", and Baskett "C" Leases is common as to working interest ownership, royalty ownership, and overriding royalty ownership, and will be allocated on the basis of individual well tests.
6. Production from the Baskett "D" and the Queen Leases, each being different ownership, will be produced through separate metering facilities and separators from the above-mentioned three Baskett Leases.
7. Production will be metered and sampled separately prior to commingling, utilizing A. O. Smith T-6 temperature compensated meters.
8. The BS&W content will be determined every eight days, and the production recorded.
9. Adequate facilities will be installed to permit determining the producing capacity of each well on each lease at least once each month, in accordance with applicable provisions of the current Commission Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities.
