Gentlemen:

Administrative Order CTB-169, dated April 18, 1967, authorizes the commingling of CATO San Andres oil production from our CROSBY, CROSBY "F", and CROSBY "G" Leases.

Our CROSBY "H" Well No. 1, located in Unit E, Section 9, T-8-S, R-30-E, Chaves County, New Mexico, was completed May 9, 1967, as a flowing, top allowable, CATO San Andres Oil Pool well.

Since the CROSBY "H" Lease, comprising the W/2 of NW/4 of Section 9, T-8-S, R-30-E, is of the same and of common working interest, royalty, and overriding royalty ownership, we hereby submit and request that Administrative Order CTB-169 be amended to provide for the inclusion of this lease.

In support of this request to permit commingling of production from these leases into the CATO Storage System IV, a common tank battery, the following is submitted:

1. Plats of the leases showing thereon the wells and formation in which they are completed.
2. Schematic diagram of the commingling facility, located in Unit G, Section 17, T-8-S, R-30-E, Chaves County, New Mexico.

3. Production is from a common source of supply, and the commercial value of the commingled production will be unchanged.
4. Production from the separate leases is common as to working interest ownership, royalty ownership, and overriding royalty ownership, and will be allocated on the basis of periodic well tests.
5. All parties owning an interest in the leases and the purchaser of the commingled production have been notified by certified mail of our intention to commingle the production from these leases.
6. Adequate facilities will be installed to permit determining the producing capacity of each well on each lease at least once each month in accordance with applicable provisions of the current Commission Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities.
