Shell Oil Company hereby makes application for administrative approval to commingle before marketing production from the Brown-Federal (SE 1/4, Section 22, T-8-S, R-30-E) and Brown Federal "A" (Section 26, T-8-S, R-30-E) Leases, Cato Field, Chaves County, New Mexico.

We propose to commingle the two leases without separately metering production from each lease as both leases are filed under State No. NM 3517 and royalty interests are common throughout. Allocation of production from each well and each lease will be based on monthly well tests.

All wells produce from the same zone with similar gravities; therefore, no change in the commercial value of the production is anticipated.

Attached for your consideration are a lease plat, schematic diagram of the proposed installation, and letters from all parties owning an interest in the leases and the purchaser of the production consenting to the proposed commingling. 




BROWN FEDERAL LEASE,




