Reference is made to your application dated September 21, 1967, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Cato-San Andres production from your Hodges-Federal "A" Lease comprising all of Section 27 and your Hodges-Federal "B" Lease comprising the W/2 of Section 34, all in Township 8 South, Range 30 East, Chaves County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that the ownership of these leases is identical throughout and that you propose to commingle said production, allocating same to each lease on the basis of monthly well tests.
