Gentlemen:

Shell Oil Company hereby makes application for administrative approval to commingle before marketing production from the Hodges-Federal "A" (Section 27, T-8-S, R-30-E) and Hodges-Federal "B" (W/2, Section 34, T-8-S, R-30-E) Leases, Cato Field, Chaves County, New Mexico.

We propose to commingle the two leases without separately metering production from each lease as both leases are filed under State No. NM-3519 and royalty interests are common throughout. Allocation of production from each well and each lease will be based on monthly well tests.

All wells produce from the same formation with similar gravity; therefore, no change in the commercial value of the production is anticipated.




