Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated December 5, 1967, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Cato-San Andres production from your Amco Federal Lease which comprises the S/2, NW/4, and W/2 NE/4 of Section 33, Township 8 South, Range 30 East and your Amco Federal "A" Lease which comprises the N/2 of Section 4, Township 9 South, Range 30 East, Chaves County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that the ownership of these leases is identical throughout and that you propose to commingle said production, allocating same to each lease on the basis of monthly well tests.

Under the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-B, Shell Oil Company is hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
