Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated March 6, 1968, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Pearsall Queen oil production from your Pearsall "A" and Pearsall "AX" Leases which comprise the N/2 and SE/4 and the SW/4, respectively, of Section 33, Township 17 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering and sampling the production of each lease.

Under the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-B, Continental Oil Company is hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters and temperature-compensated meters. Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made prior to putting it in operation.
