Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated April 17, 1968, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Middle Lane Permo-Pennsylvanian oil production from your State K-4335, K-4544, and K-5173 Leases which comprise the N/2 NE/4, SE/4 NE/4 and NW/4 of Section 13, the NE/4 of Section 14, and the S/2 of Section 12, respectively, Township 10 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production to each lease on the basis of bi-monthly well tests. Since your application was filed, the Commission has abolished the Middle Lane Permo-Pennsylvanian Pool and the subject lands are now included in the Inbe Permo-Pennsylvanian Pool.

Under authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-B, Union Oil Company of California is hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made prior to putting it in operation.
