**AMENDMENT**

**Administrative Order CTB-189**

**Gentlemen:**

Reference is made to your letter dated December 12, 1968, in which you have requested an amendment to Administrative Order CTB-189 which authorizes the commingling of Vada-Pennsylvanian production from your State TUC Lease and your State MGF Lease after separately metering and sampling the production from each lease. It is our understanding that you now wish to add your State MGF "A" Lease and also to delete the requirement for separate metering and sampling of the production from each lease.

Administrative Order CTB-189 is hereby amended to permit the commingling of Vada-Pennsylvanian production from your State Leases Nos. K-2443, K-5092, and OG-4632. Further, inasmuch as the ownership of all leases is identical throughout and the Commissioner of Public Lands for the State of New Mexico has consented thereto, you are authorized to commingle said production without separate measurement and to determine the production from each lease on the basis of monthly well tests.

Further, inasmuch as the ownership of all leases is identical throughout our and the Commission of Public Lands for the State of New Mexico has consented thereto, you are authorized to delete the separate metering and sampling requirement and to continue the production from each lease on the basis of a monthly well count.
