Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated November 19, 1968, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Chaveroo-San Andres production from your Farrell Federal Lease comprising the E/2 of Section 30 and your Lauck Federal Lease comprising all of Section 29 except the NE/4 NE/4 and NE/4 NW/4, Township 7 South, Range 33 East, Roosevelt County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each lease. We are now in receipt of the consent of the United States Geological Survey to the proposed commingling.
