Reference is made to your letter dated January 19, 1970, wherein you request the amendment of Administrative Order CTB-194 which authorizes the commingling of Todd-Lower San Andres production from your Peterson "A" Lease and your Spradley Federal Lease in Sections 20 and 29, Township 7 South, Range 36 East, Roosevelt County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each lease. It is our understanding that you now wish to include in the commingling installation Todd-Lower San Andres production from your Solsbery Federal Oil Com Lease which comprises the E/2 SE/4 of said Section 29, after separately metering the production from this lease also.

Administrative Order CTB-194 is hereby amended to include the Solsbery Federal Oil Com Lease in the commingling installation after separate and continuous metering, subject to the provision that Administrative Order CTB-194 will remain as is in all other respects.
