Reference is made to your application dated March 11, 1969, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Lovington-Devonian production from certain leases contained in your Midway Drilling Block, Lovington-Devonian Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
