Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated May 21, 1969, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Grayburg-Jackson production from that portion of your Turner "B" Federal Lease comprising the S/2 S/2 of Section 20, the N/2 N/2 and S/2 NE/4 of Section 29, and the NW/4 SE/4 and N/2 SW/4 of Section 30, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, and Grayburg-Jackson production from that portion of your Turner "A" Federal Lease comprising the S/2 NW/4 and S/2 of Section 29, and the NE/4 SE/4, S/2 SE/4, and SE/4 SW/4 of Section 30, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from Turner "B" Lease and determining the Turner Tract "A" production by means of the subtraction method.

It is our understanding that the ownership of the two leases is identical throughout.

Under the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-B, Atlantic Richfield Company is hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including non-reset counters on the meters.

It is our understanding that the ownership of the two leases is identical throughout.
