Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated August 27, 1969, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of South Flying "M" Pennsylvanian production from your Keith Crouse Lease comprising the NW/4 of Section 25, and from your Marg McGuffin Lease comprising the S/2 SW/4 of Section 24, both in Township 9 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the power oil to each lease and separately metering the combined power oil and production from each lease.

By the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-B, King Resources is hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for samplers and non-reset counters on the meters. Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the installation is complete in order that an inspection can be made thereof.

It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.
