Gentlemen:

Please accept this letter as our request to seek exception to Rule 309-A, to permit the commingling of production of Southern Minerals Corporation's State "D" Lease, Wells No. 1, 2 and 5 into our No. 1 tank battery. Wells No. 1 and 2 are located on Lease No. K-5353 and Well No. 5 being located on Lease No. K-5174 and Lease No. K-5353.

The production from each well will be tested as often as necessary to determine the amount to be allocated to each well each month. The royalty interest and working interest are the same for the wells in question.

Attached you will find a schematic diagram of production and well testing facilities for our State "D" Lease, battery No. 1. Also, a plat showing the wells, leases, and producing zone.

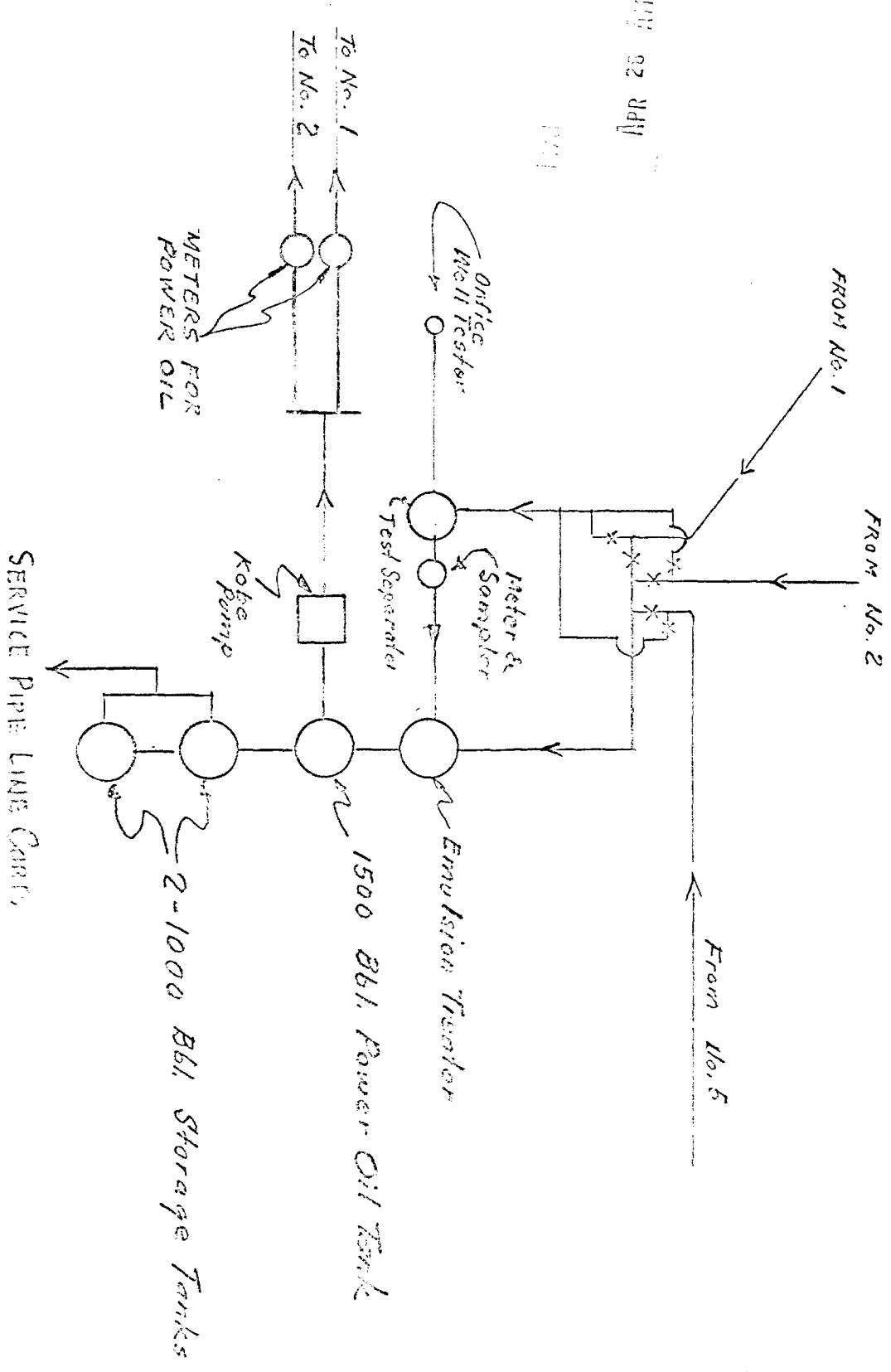
