Reference is made to your application dated February 16, 1970, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Gladiola Devonian production from your State "A-19" and State "B-19" Leases comprising the N/2 NE/4 and SE/4 NE/4 and the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 19, Township 12 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production to each lease on the basis of quarterly well tests. It is our understanding that there is no diversity of ownership between the two leases.
