The above named company is hereby authorized to commingle West Corbin Delaware (13195) Pool production from the following leases:

Lease: Quanah Federal Well No.1 (Federal Lease No.NM-17807)
Description: SE/4 SW/4 of Section 14, and;

Lease: Yuma Federal Well No.1 (Federal Lease No.NM-40452)
Description: NE/4 SWE4 , Section 14;

both located Township 18 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.


Production shall be allocated to each lease by separately metering the production from each prior to commingling.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The commingled production shall be stored in the Quanah-Yuma tank battery facility located in Unit Letter 'N', Section 14, Township 18 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Hobbs district office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling process.
