

Mr. Ben Stone:

KUKUI, INC. requests an alternative measurement method for Commingling Order CTB-465. This order is authorizing Rand Paulson Oil Company to commingle the High Plains Permo Penn (31055) Pool production from the following leases:

Lease: Estacado 27 Well No. 1 (State Lease No. VA-1127)  
Description: NE/4 SW/4 and,

Lease: Estacado 27 Well No. 3 (State Lease No. VA-998)  
Description: SE/4 NW/4,

Both in Section 27, Township 14 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

KUKUI, INC. purchased these wells from Rand Paulson effective February 1, 1999. Both leases have the same common ownership. Production is from the same common source of supply. Commingling Order CTB-465 has been obtained. A copy of this letter is being mailed certified to all owners at the time it is being mailed to the Oil Conservation Office.

KUKUI, INC. proposes to install separation and measuring equipment for the purpose of metering each well independently for approximately 15 consecutive days each month. A schematic of the proposed test facility is attached for review. Each well will be routed through the test facility with actual oil and gas volumes measured and recorded daily. The differences between tank volumes and gas sales meter volumes will yield the production for the other well. This method will more accurately reflect the production of each well.


