The above named company is hereby authorized to commingle East Herradura Bend Delaware (30670) Pool production from the following leases:

**Lease:** Quahada Ridge '31' Federal Well No.4  
**Description:** SW/4 SW/4 of Section 31, and,

**Lease:** Lentini '1' Federal Lease  
**Description:** W/2, NW/4 NE/4, NW/4 SE/4 of Section 1, and,  
NW/4 NW/4 of Section 12,

both in Township 23 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Production shall be allocated to each lease by separately metering production prior to commingling.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The commingled production shall be stored in the Lentini Federal tank battery facility located in Unit Letter 'F' of Section 1, Township 23 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Artesia district office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling process.
