Mack Energy Corporation as operator of the aforementioned leases respectfully requests administrative approval for surface commingling, off lease storage and measurement of production.

It is requested that surface commingling of "Loco Hills Abo" production be approved for the McIntyre A #4 in the NE/4 SE/4 Section 20, T17S, R30E (State of NM Lease NMLC054280) and McIntyre A #8 in the NW/4 SE/4 Section 20, T17S, R30E (State of NM Lease NMLC057634)

Mack Energy proposes to surface commingle Loco Hills Abo production at a central battery located at SE/4 SW/4, Sec. 20, T17S, R30E. We will conduct monthly well tests to determine production. The attached site facility diagram illustrates the typical separation equipment and the proposed production battery.

Mack Energy has made notification to all parties owning an interest in these leases, including the oil purchaser, of the intent to commingle. Attached, as part of this application is a copy of the sundry notice to the BLM.

The proposed operation is described in detail on the attached diagrams.

A map is enclosed showing the lease numbers and location of all leases and wells that will contribute production to the proposed commingling/common storage facility. All unitized/communitized areas, producing zones/pools are also clearly illustrated.

A schematic diagram is also attached which clearly identifies all equipment that will be utilized.

The storage and measuring facility is located at SE/SW-1/4, Sec. 20 T 17 S, R 30 E, on lease No. NM-0467932 EDDY County, New Mexico. BLM will be notified if there is any future change in the facility location.

Details of the proposed method for allocating production to contributing sources is as follows:

Mack Energy has added a test facility and will conduct well tests to make sure allocation is correct

The working interest owners have been notified of the proposal.

The proposed commingling of production is in the interest of conservation and will not result in reduced royalty or improper measurement of production.

The proposed commingling is necessary for continued operation of the above referenced Federal leases.

We understand that the requested approval will not constitute the granting of any right-of-way or construction rights not granted by the lease instrument. And, we will submit within 30 days an application for right-of-way approval to the BLM's Realty Section in your office if we have not already done so.

Additional wells require additional commingling approvals.
