The above named company is hereby authorized to commingle West Corbin Delaware (13195) Pool production from the following leases:

Lease: Corbin '13' Federal Lease
Description: NE/4 SE/4, and,

Lease: West Corbin '13' Federal Lease
Description: S/2 SE/4, and,

Lease: Uncle Sam '13' Federal Lease
Description: SE/4 NE/4,

all in Section 13, Township 18 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Production shall be allocated to each lease by separately metering the production from each lease prior to commingling.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 309-B of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The commingled production shall be stored in the tank battery facility located in Unit Letter 'P' of Section 13, Township 18 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOTE: These leases were permitted for surface commingling with production from an additional pool under Division Order PLC-102. As all the above mention leases are now producing from a single pool, Division Order PLC-102 is hereby placed in abeyance.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Artesia district office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling process.

PROVIDING: Validation of this authority shall be accomplished by like approval from the U. S. Bureau of Land Management.
