COMMINGLING ORDER CTB-481

The above named company is hereby authorized to commingle Indian Basin-Morrow Gas Pool (78960) production from the following leases:

Lease: Indian Federal Gas Com Well No. 1 (API No. 30-015-10355)
(Federal Lease No. LC-063245-A)
Description: SW/4 NE/4 of Section 19, and
Lease: Indian Federal Gas Com Well No. 2 (API No. 30-015-10971)
(Federal Lease No. NM-0238436)
Description: NW/4 SE/4 of Section 19,

all located Township 21 South, Range 24 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Production shall be allocated to each lease by well tests. This method is authorized only so long as all commingled production is of identical ownership including working interest, royalty interest, and overriding royalty interest.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 309-B of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The commingled production shall be stored and measured off-lease at the Marathon Oil Company Gas Plant located in the SW/4 NE/4 (Unit G) of Section 23, Township 21 South, Range 23 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Artesia district office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling process.

PROVIDING: Validation of this authority shall be accomplished by like approval from the U. S. Bureau of Land Management.
