Dear Mr. Hoover:

This office is in receipt of your letter of November 1, 1995, wherein you have requested our approval to surface commingle the production from the State E Well Nos. 10 and 14 at the State E No. 10 tank battery in Section 17-22S-36E. Both wells are located on state lease No. B-1536.

It is our understanding that Conoco will allocate produced volumes to each completion by monthly well tests. The well No. 10-0 produces from the Langlie Strawn and Langlie Devonian while the Well No. 14-P produces from the Langlie Devonian.

Since it appears that there will be no loss of revenue to the State of New Mexico as a result of your proposed operation, the above-mentioned request is hereby approved. Any deviation from the substance of your request will be sufficient grounds for rescinding our approval. Our approval is subject to like approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.
