Dear Ms. Staley:

The Farmington District Office (FDO) of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has received your letter dated February 7, 1996, for surface commingling of the above referenced wells.

You stated in your application that test data will be used in determining the allocation percentage for each formation. Your application indicated that the Storey LS #8 is presently producing 42 MCFPD with 0 BCPD and the Storey LS #1A is expected to produce 155 MCFPD and .7 BCPD. Allocation will be determined for the Mesaverde using quarterly testing for the first year, and annual testing for the Pictured Cliffs. Subsequent to the first year, annual production test will be conducted for each well.

To surface commingle two wells located on the same Federal lease, no prior approval is necessary unless the lease is communitized or unitized with other leases. Approval to surface commingle is granted, however we would appreciate that once determined, that you submit allocation factors for these wells.
