The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle Gavilan Greenhorn Granero Dakota and Gavilan Mancos Pool production from the following wells:

Well: Howard Federal Well No.43-15
Description: E/2 Section 15
Well: Ingram Federal Well No.43-16
Description: E/2 Section 16


Both in Township 25 North, Range 2 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

Production shall be allocated to each lease by separately metering individual well production by allocation meters and multiplying said volumes by an allocation factor. The allocation factor shall be determined by dividing the central sales meter volume by the sum of the individual allocation meter volumes.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Aztec District Office of the Division upon implementation of the commingling process.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 309-B of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.
