Amendment  
Administrative Order PC-82

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated September 29, 1964, wherein you advise that all zones producing into the commingled tank battery on your G. L. Erwin "a" Lease under authority of Administrative Order PC-82 are now of marginal nature. The subject order authorizes the commingling after separately metering the production from the Tubb Drinkard and Devonian zones using the subtraction method for determining the Blinebry production.

Administrative Order PC-82 is hereby amended to delete the requirement for separate measurement prior to commingling. Texaco Inc. shall, however, notify the Commission in the event that any well producing from any of the commingled pools becomes capable of top allowable production.
