Amendment
Administrative Order PC-80

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of June 29, 1962, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-80, dated May 3, 1962, which authorized you to commingle the production from the Tubb-Drinkard, Devonian, Fusselman, McKee, and Ellenburger Pools, North Justis Field, underlying your G. L. Erwin "b" (NCT-2) Lease comprising the SE/4 of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that you now have Waddell zone production on this lease and that the previously considered sour crude Blinebry production has been reclassified as intermediate sweet crude, and that you therefore now desire to include the Waddell and Blinebry production with the aforementioned commingled zones. Positive displacement meters will be installed on all zones for measurement prior to commingling.

Administrative Order PC-80 is hereby amended to include the Waddell zone and the Blinebry zone in the commingling authority.
