Amendment
Administrative Order PC-80


Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of September 25th requesting an amendment to Administrative Order PC-80 which granted certain commingling authority on your G. L. Erwin (b) NCT-2 Lease underlying the SE/4 of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico. We have now received copy of consent by the United States Geological Survey to the proposed new commingling installation.

It is our understanding that in order to satisfy the requirements of the United States Geological Survey and also the Oil Conservation Commission, the Montoya zone for the E/2, the Fusselman zone for the E/2, the Devonian zone for the E/2, and the Blaine zone for the E/2 will each be separately metered; the Fusselman zone from the W/2, the Devonian zone from the W/2, and the Blaine zone from the W/2 will each be separately metered; and that the Ellenburger zone for the entire lease, the McKee for the entire lease, the Drinkard for the entire lease, and the Waddell for the entire lease will each be separately metered.

Administrative Order PC-80 is hereby amended to permit the commingling in the aforesaid manner.
