Dear Mr. Pool:

We have received your application requesting approval to surface commingle production from the Remuda Basin State Lease, Remuda Basin 19 Fee Lease and the Remuda Basin Federal lease. The production from the subject leases will be commingled in a common storage facility located in Unit Letter F, Section 19, Township 23S, Range 30E, Eddy County, New Mexico, at the Remuda Basin Tank Battery.

We understand that production from the Remuda Basin State Lease will be metered separately from the federal and fee leases.

Since it appears that there will be no loss of revenue to the State of New Mexico as a result of your proposed operation, your request is hereby approved. Any deviation from the substance of your request will be sufficient grounds for rescinding our approval. Our approval is subject to like approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.

Since the Remuda Basin 19 Fee wells and the Remuda Basin 19 Federal wells are utilizing the tank battery on State Lease No. E-5229-7, a right-of-way easement and business lease may be required for a portion of the SE/4NW/4 of Section 19-23S-30E. Please contact Ms. Debra Padilla of our Right-of-Way Section for further information regarding a right-of-way easement. Ms. Padilla's telephone number is 827-5729.
