The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle Penrose Skelly Grayburg (Oil - 50350), and Drinkard (Oil - 19190) Pool production from the following leases:

Lease: Rinewalt 'A' Well No.1
Description: NW/4 of Section 4, and,

Lease: Rinewalt Well No.1
Description: NW/4 of Section 4,

both in Township 22 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Production shall be allocated to each lease by monthly well tests. (If this method is to be authorized, all production must be of identical ownership including working interest, royalty interest and overriding royalty interest.)


FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Hobbs District Office of the Division upon implementation of the commingling process.

REMARKS: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 309-B of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

NOTE: The commingled production shall be stored in the Rinewalt tank battery facility located in the NW/4 of Section 4, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOTE: Validation of this authority shall be accomplished with like approval by the New Mexico State Land Office, Oil and Gas Division.
