Attention: Ms. Candace R. Graham:

The above named company is hereby authorized to commingle East Catclaw-Draw (10500), and Avalon-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas (71000) Pool production from the following leases:

Lease: Western Reserve Federal Lease (Federal Lease No. RNM126)
Description: SW/4 NE/4 of Section 4, Township 21 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, and

Lease: Cactus '9B' Federal and Devon Federal Leases (Federal Lease No. NM0400877)
Description: W/2 NE/4 of Section 9, Township 21 South, Range 26 East, NMPM,

all in Eddy County, New Mexico.

Production shall be allocated to each lease by separately metering the production from each lease prior to commingling.

NOTE: The commingled natural gas production shall be delivered to an off lease measuring facility located in the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 16, Township 21 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOTE: Liquid production shall be separated, stored, and sold at each wellsite.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 309-B of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.


FURTHER: The operator shall notify the supervisor of the Artesia district office prior to implementation of the commingling process.
