ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-1456, John H. Trigg has made application to the Commission on October 1, 1959, for permission to expand its Caprock Queen Water Flood Project in the Caprock-Queen Pool, Lea and Chaves Counties, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 16th day of October, 1959, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-1456.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-1456.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, John H. Trigg, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

John H. Trigg Well No. 5 located in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 4 and John H. Trigg Well No. 7 located in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 4 both in Township 14 South, Range 31 East, NMPM.
