Reference is made to your letter of December 9, 1959, requesting approval to substitute McNutt State Well No. 17 for McNutt State Well No. 12 in Administrative Order No. WFX-19.

It is our understanding that it was necessary to plug and abandon McNutt State No. 12 prior to completion and that McNutt State No. 17 was drilled in lieu of and approximately 50 feet from McNutt State 12.

Graridge Corporation is hereby authorized to substitute for McNutt State Well No. 12, an injection well, McNutt State Well No. 17, an injection well, located 1685 feet from the South line and 955 feet from the West line of Section 21, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, in Administrative Order WFX-19.
