ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Cities Service Oil Company has made application to the Commission on December 7, 1959, for permission to expand its Drickey Queen Sand Unit Water Flood Project in the Caprock-Queen Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 22nd day of December, 1959, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order 701.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Cities Service Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to-wit:

Tract 3 Well No. 1 - NW/4 SE/4 Section 10
Tract 6 Well No. 1 - SE/4 NW/4 Section 10
Tract 6 Well No. 4 - SE/4 NE/4 Section 10
Tract 6 Well No. 13 - SE/4 NE/4 Section 3
Tract 6 Well No. 16 - SE/4 NW/4 Section 3
Tract 6 Well No. 20 - NW/4 NE/4 Section 3
Tract 38 Well No. 2 - NW/4 SW/4 Section 2
Tract 40 Well No. 1 - SE/4 SW/4 Section 2
Tract 47 Well No. 2 - NW/4 NW/4 Section 11

All located in Township 14 South, Range 31 East, Chaves County, New Mexico.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer in each well set at a depth well below the top of the cement outside the casing.
