

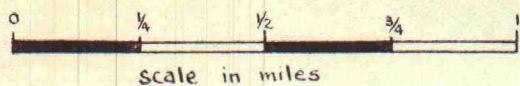

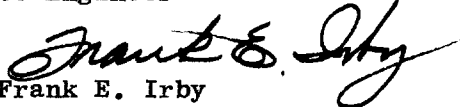
Reference is made to John H. Trigg Company's application for administrative approval for the conversion of three producing unit wells to water injection wells within the John H. Trigg water flood project, Chaves County, New Mexico which was dated March 8, 1960.
