ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-952-A, Graridge Corporation has made application to the Commission on April 6, 1960, for permission to expand its Artesia Flood No. 1 Water Flood Project in the Artesia Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 18<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-952-A.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-952-A.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Graridge Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Premier Sand formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Solt State Welch Well No. 3 and Solt State Welch Well No. 5 both located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 4, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set well below the top of the cement outside the 4½-inch casing in aforesaid Wells No. 3 and 5.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
