ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Great Western Drilling Company has made application to the Commission on July 22, 1960, for permission to expand its Rock Queen Unit Water Flood Project in the Caprock-Queen Pool, Lea and Chaves Counties, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 8th day of August, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Great Western Drilling Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following-described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Unit Well No. 26-4 located in the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 26 and Unit Well No. 27-8 located in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 27, both in Township 13 South, Range 31 East, NMPM.
