ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-972-B, Graridge Corporation has made application to the Commission on September 19, 1960, for permission to expand its North Caprock Queen Unit No. 1 Water Flood Project in the Caprock-Queen Pool, Lea and Chaves Counties, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 4th day of October, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-972-B.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-972-B.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, Graridge Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Unit Well No. 8-6 located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 8, Township 13 South, Range 32 East, NMPM,

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that water injected into said well shall be of such nature that contamination of fresh water zones could not occur should casing leakage develop.

Done at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
