ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-1311, Great Western Drilling Company has made application to the Commission on September 30, 1960, for permission to expand its North Central Caprock Queen Unit Water Flood Project in the Caprock-Queen Pool, Lea and Chaves Counties, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 13th day of October, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-1311.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-1311.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Great Western Drilling Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Unit Well No. 14-12 located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 14 and Unit Well No. 14-14 located in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 14, both in Township 13 South, Range 31 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set at approximately 3000 feet in aforesaid wells.

Done at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
