ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Kersey and Company, has made application to the Commission on April 3, 1961, for permission to expand its Red Lake Premier Sand Unit Water Flood Project in the Red Lake Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 21st day of April, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Kersey and Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Welch Reid Well No. 3 located in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 20 and Tigner Well No. 1 located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 28, both in Township 17 South, Range 28 East, NMPM.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
