ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-1110-B, Newmont Oil Company has made application to the Commission on July 24, 1961, for permission to expand its Lower Grayburg-Upper San Andres Water Flood Project in the Square Lake Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 7th day of August, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-1110-B.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of the Order No. R-1110-B.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Newmont Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Lower Grayburg and Upper San Andres formations through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Bruning Unit Well No. 5 located in the NE/4 SE/4
of Section 29, Township 16 South, Range 31 East,
NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set in the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch casing well below the top of the cement outside the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch casing in said well.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
