ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-1470, Kersey and Company has made application to the Commission on October 30, 1961, for permission to expand its Twin Lakes Water Flood Project in the Artesia Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 14th day of November, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objections has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-1470.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-1470.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Kersey and Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

- Twin Lakes Well No. 7 located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 28
- Twin Lakes Well No. 12 located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 28
- Twin Lakes Well No. 13 located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 28
- all in Township 18 South, Range 28 East, NMPM.
