ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Great Western Drilling Company has made application to the Commission on August 19, 1963, for permission to expand its Malmar Unit Water Flood Project in the Maljamar Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 3rd day of September, 1963, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Great Western Drilling Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Unit Well No. 12-10 located in the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 12, and Unit Well No. 12-14 located in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 12, both in Township 17 South, Range 32 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water down tubing with packers set at approximately 4000 feet in the oil strings of said wells.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
