ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Cities Service Oil Company has made application to the Commission on January 28, 1964, for permission to expand its Drickey Queen Sand Unit Water Flood Project in the Caprock-Queen Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 14th day of February, 1964, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Cities Service Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Tract 23 Well No. 1 located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 16,
Tract 25 Well No. 1 located in the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 16, both in Township 14 South, Range 31 East, NMPM and Tract 37 Well No. 6 located in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 35, Township 13 South, Range 31 East, NMPM,

PROVIDED HOWEVER: That applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set well below the top of the cement surrounding the production strings of said wells.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
