ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, William A. and Edward R. Hudson has made application to the Commission on May 12, 1964, for permission to expand its Maljamar-Puckett No. 1 Water Flood Project in the Maljamar Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 27th day of May, 1964, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, William A. and Edward R. Hudson, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the San Andres formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Puckett "A" Well No. 24 located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 24 and Puckett "A" Well No. 25 located in the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 13, both in Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
