ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2268-A, Sinclair Oil & Gas Company has made application to the Commission on January 4, 1965, for permission to expand its Keel-West Water Flood Project in the Grayburg-Jackson Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 19th day of January, 1965, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2268-A.
4. That the proposed well is eligible for completion as a water injection well under the terms of Order No. R-2268-A and should be authorized as substitution for the H. E. West "A" Well No. 1 in State III expansion.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, Sinclair Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

H. E. West "A" Well No. 13 located in the NE/4 NW/4
of Section 3, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM,

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 3385 feet in the 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ inch casing in said well.
